DRESS CODE FOR TRAVEL DAYS: No ripped pants, sweats, leggings, yoga pants, or shorts during travel. Students are to wear their choir polo and a pair of nice jeans or pants (girls can wear capris). Students are encouraged to keep their polos and pants clean for the trip back to DC.

❖ LUGGAGE CHECK-IN, Choir Room, 7:30 − 8:10 AM:

2. Luggage Check - in Choir Room

- a. Please read through the Field Trip Luggage Search form. We would encourage you to fill out both PART I and PART II certifying that you searched your child's luggage but also allowing us to check it if needed.
- b. A chaperone will ask to visually see all pieces of your student's choir uniform, including shoes so please pack those on top.
- c. A chaperone will ask to visually see your student's ID.
- d. Carry-ons will be double-checked for TSA compliance:
 - Make sure any liquids are in luggage to be checked (if girls have lipstick, put in checked baggage or put in Ziploc bag to go through security).
- e. Luggage will be tagged according to bus assignment (green or gold)
- 3. Students take luggage to Dressing Rooms and go to class.
